Is It Reliable?

Argued that Mark 16:9-20 is not reliable since it is missing in two of the oldest Manuscripts



Codex Vaticanus



Codex Sinaiticus

Are over 5,000 extant MSS

Mark 16:9-20

1. Much missing from those same MSS
 - Vaticanus: Heb 9:14-ff; Timothy, Titus, Revelation or Philemon
 - Sinaiticus: Matt. 1-24; John (parts) & 2 Corinthians
2. It is found in hundreds of MSS. Majority of the MSS do contain it
3. Translators who left it in: (47 of KJV; 101 of ASV; 119 of NKJV)
4. Authenticity not questioned - only its genuineness
 - Did Mark or some other writer pen it?
 - In Vatican - scribe left place for it indicating - uncertain whether to insert it or not
 - Only question was *where*
5. Every point in vv. 9-20 can be corroborated by other text - not statement not true!
