
Eph. 2:14-16 <sup>14</sup> For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, 6 15 having <u>abolished</u> in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of separated commandments contained in Jew / Gentile ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, Law abolished <sup>16</sup> and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.



Old law passing Away Context: contrast OT to NT

2 Cor. 3:6-18

6 who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

7 But if the ministry of death, written and engraved on stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of the glory of his countenance, which glory was passing away.

8 how will the ministry of the Spirit not be more glorious?

9 For if the ministry of condemnation had glory, the ministry of righteousness exceeds much more in glory

2 Cor. 3:6-18

10 For even what was made glorious had no glory in this respect, because of the glory that excels.

11 For if what is passing away was glorious, what remains is much more glorious.

12 Therefore, since we have such hope, we use great boldness of speech--

13 unlike Moses, who put a veil over his face so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the end of what was passing away.

2 Cor. 3:6-18

14 But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ.

15 But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart.

16 Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.

17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

18 But we all, with <u>unveiled face</u> beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.




